The Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act requires certain professionals to tell of actual or suspected instances of child abuse and child neglect. A “ child,” under this statute, is defined as any person under the age of 18. 1

Professionals required to report under CANRA are referred to as “ mandatory reporters.”

## **California’s Mandated Reporter Law**

The extent of mandatory reporting varies considerably, both in terms of what is reportable and who is mandated to report. Over the past decades, most states have considerably expanded their mandatory reporting laws in both domains, although none have proven the effectiveness of this approach.

### **Child Abuse Identification & Reporting Guidelines - Child ...**

□Any person who is required by law to report a particular category or type of abuse to the appropriate law enforcement or social service agency. Mandated Reporters are legally responsible to report the incident themselves.

### **California Mandated Reporting Requirements**

If you are a mandated reporter with an allegation involving an incapacitated adult and/or resident of a nursing home or residential facility, you are required by law to complete the APS Mandatory Reporting Form within 48 hours as part of the Adult Protective Services (APS) process. ### **Centralized Intake for Abuse and Neglect**

It is intended that mandatory reporting will cause the protective services of the state to be brought to bear on the situation in an effort to prevent abuses, to protect and enhance the welfare of children, and to preserve family life wherever possible. This Code section shall be liberally construed so as to carry out the purposes thereof.

### **Mandated Reporting | Georgia Office of the Child Advocate**

Although anyone can report child and dependent adult abuse and are encouraged to do so, mandatory reporters are required by law to make a report of suspected abuse within 24 hours of becoming aware of the concern (s). If a child or dependent adult is in imminent danger, CALL 911 immediately.

By law, mandatory reporters must report suspected abuse or neglect of a child regardless of whether or not the knowledge of the abuse was gained in the reporter's official capacity. In other words, the mandatory reporting of abuse or neglect of children is a 24-hour obligation.

Mandatory reporters are not required by law to report situations of self-neglect, but DSHS urges mandatory reporters to do so as a way to help vulnerable adults. As a mandatory reporter, you must ALSO make a report immediately to law enforcement if you suspect sexual assault and types of physical assault (see RCW 74.34.035).
